Price details:

The above mentioned base prices and if applicable surcharges includes the crossing for the bus, all passengers incl. driver and/or guide. The prices are excluding ETS surcharge, fuel surcharge (BAF), and if applicable passenger supplement plus Bus Handling Fee in the ports. Except Combination tickets with the Øresund Bridge all other ticket prices are not subject to VAT. The Combination ticket with Øresund Bridge includes 25% VAT on the partial amount for the Øresund Bridge.

Base price (yellow table):

The price is valid for a single crossing on the booked departure day and time, and all other departures with free capacity on the booked calendar day.

Combination tickets with Øresund Bridge:

Is valid for 7 days after the initial Scandlines crossing. You are welcome to take a stopover in Denmark.

Surcharges and Return options

High season Surcharge:

The surcharge will be added on crossings booked in high season based on our [price calendar](#).

Bus >14 meter Surcharge:

The surcharge will be added on busses with length exceeding 14 meters. Please notice: All lengths shall be incl. of bicycle and ski boxes or other vehicle trailers.

Example: A single crossing for a bus in high season, exceeding 14 m



Base price (Puttgarden–Rødby): 392 EUR
High season Surcharge: 80 EUR
Bus >14 meter Surcharge: 50 EUR

= Total price*: 522 EUR (+ 1x BAF/ETS surcharge)

Return options (price explanation)

To book a ticket with a 1- or 2-Day Return, add the relevant return option price to the base price.

Example: A 1-Day Return ticket in low season, bus ≤ 14 m



Base price (Rostock–Gedser): 452 EUR
1-Day Return: 137 EUR

= Total price*: 589 EUR (+ 2x BAF/ETS surcharge)

1-Day Return (incl. 1-Day Round trip):

The price is valid for a 1-Day Return trip performed by the same bus and amount of passengers on the same booked calendar day. Not valid for empty or transfer busses or for line bus services.

2-Day Return**:

The price is valid for a 2-Day Return trip performed by the same bus and amount of passengers. The return trip must take place the day after the outbound trip. Only available in low season for two consecutive days of travel.

Not valid for empty or transfer busses or for line bus services.

12 hours Return*:

(only available for Combination with the Øresund Bridge)

The price is valid for a 12 hours trip performed by the same bus (license plate number) and amount of passengers. The return trip at the Øresund Bridge must take place latest 12 hours after the outbound trip and the Scandlines return trip latest 15 hours after the arrival the outbound trip. All trips need to be performed on the same calendar day. Only available for outbound trips from German ports in connection with the Øresund Bridge.

Not valid for empty or transfer busses or for line bus services.

Bunker Adjustment Factor (BAF):

The BAF fuel surcharge is adjusted every 3 months and is charged per bus and single trip on the routes Puttgarden–Rødby and Rostock–Gedser, including combination tickets to Sweden. In case of rebooking or use of a different departure than originally booked, the currently applicable fuel surcharge will be charged. The current fuel surcharge is published on our webpage bus.scandlines.com

ETS surcharge:

According to EU regulations (ETS), a new CO₂ contribution has been applied to the entire transport and travel industry from 2024. This surcharge is calculated per transported vehicle/passenger, depending on the share of the total CO₂ load and the applicable ETS CO₂ pricing. The amount may vary over time and will be published and updated on the [Scandlines website](#).

Green Investment Rate (GIR):

From 2027, the sustainability surcharge (Green Investment Rate / GIR) will be discontinued and integrated into the base ticket price for all crossings on the Puttgarden–Rødby and Rostock–Gedser routes, including combination tickets, reflecting sustainability as a core part of Scandlines' operations.

Bus Handling Fee:

If you would like to purchase and pay for your bus crossing in the ports, the ticket will be charged an additional Bus Handling Fee starting at **50 EUR**, exception on Self-Service Check-in lanes on route Rødby-Puttgarden. Registered clients with a valid customer ID book as well without handling fee.

Supplement for busses with > 60 passengers:

The supplement applies to each ferry crossing on the routes Puttgarden–Rødby and Rostock–Gedser, if the number exceeds 60 passengers incl. driver and guide. This also applies to the Combination tickets to Sweden. In 2027, the supplement for busses is **60 EUR** per single crossing. If the number of passengers changes to less than 61 passengers the Service Center has to be informed according to our [booking information](#) (see page 7). Even if the number of passengers is changed on the departure day at check-in and not communicated in advance, the supplement will remain and will be invoiced.

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Timetables

General information:

The current timetables incl. night departure times are published on our web page: bus.scandlines.com

The check-in time indicates the time when all official check-in procedures (customs clearance and border control) and check-in for the ferry crossing must be accomplished. The check-in time for all busses must be completed: up to 15 minutes prior to departure at all ports except up to 30 minutes before departure in Rostock-Überseehafen. We encourage you to provide the bus licence plate number by booking or before departure for smooth check-in.

Check-in methods in the ports



PUTTGARDEN-RØDBY v.v.:

Automated ferry check-in for busses

Faster check-in for busses with the Scandlines self-service lane.

In Puttgarden (Germany) and Rødby (Denmark) Scandlines offers the option for busses to check in without having to enter the check-in building. Easy and automatic via the self-service lane.

The most efficient process is achieved when the correct bus license plate is already stored in the pre-booking. The cameras in the self-service lane automatically recognizes the license plate and initiates the check-in process. Alternatively, the driver can scan the QR code on the booking confirmation at the self-service kiosk or manually enter the booking number.

PUTTGARDEN-RØDBY | ROSTOCK-GEDSER v.v.:

Check-in at the staffed buildings

It is possible to use the self-service lane, but we of course also offer staffed check-in on the Puttgarden-Rødby route as well as on the Rostock-Gedser route. There is no automated check-in on the Rostock-Gedser route.

Cancellation

If the Service Center shall handle the cancellation on the same day, the cancellation must be received before 12:00 noon in writing or by email to gruppen@scandlines.com.

Rebooking

The rebooking is free of charge. It must be communicated in writing at least 2 hours before origin departure. The latest conditions will apply.

Please notice: If the bus arrives earlier or later than the originally booked departure, then it can be rebooked on the next free available space depending on capacity.

Booking via Scandlines Service Center

Bookings are accepted only in written form to the Service Center e.g. by [email](mailto:gruppen@scandlines.com). With the booking you accept the [General Conditions of Carriage of Scandlines Deutschland GmbH](#). A booking becomes binding for both parties when the booking party receives a written booking confirmation.

Please inform us already about the length of the bus and the expected number of passengers when placing the booking. All lengths shall be inclusive of bicycle and ski boxes or other vehicle trailers. Please confirm the final number of passengers in the bus **no later than one week before departure** by [email](mailto:gruppen@scandlines.com) or phone.

Please note that Scandlines cannot guarantee to carry the bus if the length and/or number of passengers exceeds the numbers confirmed on the confirmation paper.

Emergency phone number

We kindly ask you to inform our Service Center about your emergency phone number every time you book a ferry ticket.

The phone number will be registered in the booking system so that Scandlines can contact your company in case of special circumstances – also outside normal office opening hours.

Booking deadlines for heavily requested departures for busses
